 - a. Outstanding skill
 - b. Progression through the umpire pathway
 - c. Dedication to mentoring, badging or assisting umpires
- 5. Presents a positive image for the Member Associations
- 6. Shows commitment to working as a team and supporting the development of other umpires.

Please nominate one badged Umpire from your Association to be considered.

Include a brief profile and supporting information.

ALL nominees will be officially recognised and awarded at the NT Link Championship closing ceremony, 2 May 2021.

The successful recipient will be decided by the NNT Officials Advisory Panel (OAP)
