Primary Objectives	The Team Manager will undertake organisational duties which support the Head Coach to deliver a high quality program, be responsible for team adherence to NA and NNT policies and procedures, and maintain program deadlines.
Position Capabilities	 The position requires a high level of: Demonstrated experience working as part of a team to achieve the Head Coach objectives High degree of planning and organisational skills The ability to react to short term problems and opportunities Interpersonal, engagement and communication capabilities Flexibility, adaptability and resilience
Position Location	The Team Manager must be located within the NT and be based in Alice Springs, Darwin or Palmerston regions.
Salary, Tenure and Program Commitment	The NNT 17U & 19U NNC Team Managers are volunteer positions and will be appointed for a period of six (6) months. The program will commence in November 2023 and end in April 2024. An honorarium will be provided in April 2024 upon completion of all
	the Team Manager duties. The working hours will vary depending on the program schedule. It is anticipated that most working hours will be out of hours and may include early morning, late afternoon, and/or weekend sessions. Interstate travel for National Championships and training camps will also be required.
