Salary, Tenure and Program Commitment	The NNT 17U & 19U NNC Head Coach positions are volunteer positions and will be appointed for a period of six (6) months. The program will commence in November 2024 and end in April 2025. An honorarium wil be provided in May 2025 upon completion of all the Head Coach duties. As a volunteer position, the working hours will vary depending on the time required by the program schedule. It is anticipated that most working hours will be out of hours and may include early morning, late afternoon, and/or weekend sessions. Interstate travel for National
